

**Minutes from the April 18, 2023 Annual Meeting of Electors for the
Town of Chetek**

With the meeting being properly noticed, Chairman Postle called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. All Board members present (Hanson arrived 5:06)

The minutes from the April 2022 Annual Meeting of the Electors were approved as presented on a motion by Postle/Carlson. Motion carried.

The 2022 Financial Report was discussed. The report is not complete. A draft of the Schedule 2 Revenues, Expenditures and Changes in Fund Balance was presented. No issues were noted during the audit fieldwork. The full and final report will be added to the May Regular Meeting agenda. A motion to accept the presented information by Postle/J Haslehuhn. Motion carried.

The banking needs of the town were discussed. Motion to keep banking services at Sterling Bank in Chetek by Carlson/Trowbridge. Motion carried.

The insurance needs of the town were discussed. Motion to keep Rural Mutual as insurance provider made by Trowbridge/T Haslehuhn. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Lentz/Trowbridge to donate \$1,000 to the Chetek Fireworks; \$1,000 to the Chetek Food Shelf; \$2,000 to the Chetek Hydroflites; \$2,000 Chetek Youth Baseball. Motion carried.


Trowbridge spoke in favor of the Town purchasing Badger Books (electronic poll books) the benefits being time savings and further assurance of accuracy. The clerk will get a cost estimate.



Roads & equipment. New truck purchase in process—could take 2 years to receive. Road tour set for Monday May 1st at 7:00a.
