

Minutes from the December 7, 2022 Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors for the Town of Chetek

With the meeting being properly noticed, Chairman Postle called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m. All members were present.

The minutes from the November 16, 2022 Regular Board meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Hanson and seconded by Lentz. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's report was presented showing a balance of \$726,889.77 before bills are paid. Motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson report accepted as presented.

Building inspector's report accepted without comment.

Public input—none.

A discussion regarding wage increases for 2023 was held. The county is increasing wages 4% for the coming year. A schedule of current wages and salaries for all employees and officers was presented. It included a proforma of compensation for 2023 with a 4% increase. A motion to approve a 4% increase effective January 1st for hourly workers and according to the contract renewal dates for salaried and officers was made by Lentz and seconded by Hanson. No increase was proposed for casual labor at this time. Motion carried unanimously.

Resolution 22-005 of the Town Board Proposing to Exceed the Levy Limit reflecting the increase with the final new construction amounts from the state was reviewed. The increase was less than originally estimated by 0.12%. A motion to approve the resolution was made by Lentz and seconded by Hanson. Motion carried unanimously.

Roads & equipment

- A question was raised as to the status of the TRIP paperwork. Will follow up for current information.

An update on the General Election November 8th was given.


Election update. All elections for 2022 have been successfully concluded with the county and state.
