

## **Minutes from the March 22, 2023 Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors for the Town of Chetek**

With the meeting being properly noticed, Chairman Postle called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. All were present except Dave Lentz.

The minutes from the February 8, 2023 Regular Board meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Hanson and seconded by Postle. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's report was presented showing a balance of \$821,383.45 before bills are paid. Motion by Hanson and seconded by Postle to accept report as presented.

Building inspector's report – February report was presented: no changes.

Approve building permits—driveway permit for Blatz was presented. Motion by Hanson and seconded by Postle to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Public input—questions have been raised regarding applicability of road bans to garbage trucks. They are required to adhere to the weight limitations.

Applications for operator licenses from Kollwitz and McCarthy were presented. Motion by Hanson and seconded by Postle to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

The special exception request to change a duplex rental to a cabin rental as part of Lazy Moose Resort and to build a workshop/office on the same property was discussed. Motion by Hanson and seconded by Postle in favor of request. Motion carried unanimously.

The special exception request to build a garage adjacent to the road at 2530 9 5/8 Avenue was discussed. The building will not interfere with snow plowing. Motion by Hanson and seconded by Postle in favor of request. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussed request by resort owner for the Town to provide a dock for the landing next to their property. The patrons using the landing are currently using the resort's dock when they launch boats. The Board will view the situation in person during the road tour in the Spring.
