

Minutes from the March 9, 2022 Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors for the Town of Chetek

With the meeting being properly noticed, Chairman Postle called the meeting to order at 4:58 p.m. All members were present.

The minutes from the February 9, 2022 Regular Board meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson. Motion approved.

The Treasurer's report was presented showing a balance of \$823,733.75 before bills are paid. Motion to approve the report was made by Hanson and seconded by Lentz. Motion approved.

The building inspector report showed one new permit issued since the last meeting.

Public input—Fran Langman, candidate for Barron County Board of Supervisors representing part of the Town of Chetek, appeared to introduce himself and describe why he is running.

On a motion by Hanson and seconded by Lentz, all were approved.

The proposal for broadband expansion within the Town was discussed. Denny Bachman from Citizens Connected was present to answer questions. The company is asking for Town participation in the cost of the expansion along with an application by Citizens for a grant to cost share with the State. On a motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson, the Board approved a commitment of \$5,000.00 and agreed to Resolutions 22-002 and 22-003 (Resolution Supporting Improved Broadband Access in the Town of Chetek and Resolution in Support of Telecommuting Opportunities and Telecommuter Forward Certification, respectively). The motion was approved unanimously.

Roads & equipment—road bans will go on Monday the 14th.
