

Minutes from the May 10, 2023 Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors for the Town of Chetek

With the meeting being properly noticed, Chairman Postle called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. All were present.

The minutes from the April 18, 2023 Regular Board meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Hanson and seconded by Lentz. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's report was presented showing a balance of \$819,397.82 before bills are paid. Motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson to accept report as presented.

Building inspector's report – April report was presented.

Building permits were presented.

Public input—resident appeared to discuss the possible placement of a dock adjacent to the boat landing next to Klay's resort.

Members of the Bass Lake Association appeared to discuss their list of work they would like to perform at the main boat landing and clean up at the east side boat landing.

Reviewed the request for a plat subdivision of Lot 8 on Plat of Summerville. The board requested that Outlot 1 to be used for cemetery purposes be attached to one of the other proposed lots to assure there is responsibility for maintaining the cemetery in the future. The applicant will request a new survey to include those changes.

Reviewed the amendments to the Chetek Fire District Articles of Agreement. Motion to approve made by Lentz and seconded by Hanson. Motion carried unanimously.

An offer by the County to sell a small parcel adjacent to Town owned land on Bass Lake was discussed. A motion to approve the purchase for \$200 was made by Postle and seconded by Lentz. Motion carried unanimously.

Roads & equipment—nothing to report. A request has been made to add a stop sign at the end of 11th Avenue near Back of the Moon resort/campground. The road foreman will visit the site and install sign as appropriate.

Information—no action

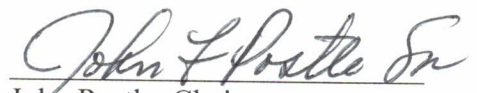
- Land use and sanitary permit listings
