

Minutes from the November 16, 2022 Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors for the Town of Chetek

With the meeting being properly noticed, Chairman Postle called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. All members were present.

The minutes from the October 13, 2022 Regular Board meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's report was presented showing a balance of \$879,149.83 before bills are paid. Motion by Hanson and seconded by Lentz report accepted as presented.

Building inspector's report accepted without comment.

The building permit was approved on a motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson.

Public input—none.

Application for operator license for Cameron was presented. Motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

A discussion of the Fire District levy was conducted. Changes to the formula used to calculate the members contributions to the district for 2023 were reviewed. A motion to approve the revised levy calculation was made by Lentz and seconded by Hanson. Motion carried unanimously.

Resolution 22-005 of the Town Board Proposing to Exceed the Levy Limit was discussed. A motion to approve the resolution was made by Lentz and seconded by Hanson. Motion carried unanimously.

An update on the status of the road abandonments within and adjacent to the Crimson Hue Resort. Additional information has been gathered. Improvements to other landing(s) must be documented. The next step is to submit the project to the DNR for approval. The submission should be ready by January.

The board wants further information on the requirements for assuming responsibility for maintenance of 10 3/8 Avenue.
