

Minutes from the October 13, 2022 Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors for the Town of Chetek

With the meeting being properly noticed, Chairman Postle called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. All members were present.

The minutes from the September 14, 2022 Regular Board meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's report was presented showing a balance of \$875,422.89 before bills are paid. Motion by Hanson and seconded by Lentz report accepted as presented.

Building inspector's report accepted without comment.

The building permits were on a motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson

Public input—none.

Applications for operator licenses from Grey and Lundequam were presented. Motion by Hanson and seconded by Lentz to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

A resolution discontinuing two roads (rights-of-way) in the Town was presented. The roads near and within the Crimson Hue resort property are not maintained by the Town and not used by the public. The resolution which is subject to approval by the DNR was adopted on a motion by Lentz and seconded by Hanson. Motion carried unanimously. An application will be made to the DNR with the adopted resolution. If it is approved by the DNR, a public hearing and vote to approve the resolution will be scheduled and separately noticed.

A discussion of the Fire District levy was conducted. Representatives of the participating municipalities were present. The history of the district's funding agreement was presented. Members discussed possible changes to the formula used to calculate the members contributions to the district for 2023 and the following four years. The board will meet in the next few weeks to consider the proposal.

Roads & equipment

- The 'island bridge' project is now slated for 2023. The DNR and County are working together to on the project.

An update on the General Election November 8th was given.

Bills were reviewed and checks 20288 – 20314 and electronic payments of payroll, taxes and retirement. In addition, the payroll reports from the payroll service were reviewed. Motion by Hanson and seconded by Lentz to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Next meeting will be Wednesday November 16, 2022 immediately following the Annual Budget Meeting which begins at 5:00 p.m.

Motion by Hanson and seconded by Lentz to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
